Marshall University Softball is offering a Winter Clinic in the Chris Cline Athletic Complex Indoor Facility. This first class climate controlled facility opened in Oct. 2014 and includes a full 100 yd football field, cages, and track. The camp will feature instruction and interaction with 3X Olympic Gold Medalist Lori Harrigan-Mack. Cost is \$60 per session or \$90 for both sessions.

PITCHING CLINIC: 1:30-3:30pm Cost \$60

You do not want to miss out on this opportunity to receive instruction from one of four softball athletes in the world that have 3 Olympic Gold Medals. We recommend pitchers bring their own catcher.

CATCHING CLINIC: 1:30-3:30pm Cost \$60

This clinic is geared to the development of catchers at all skill levels. Catchers will receive instruction on stance, receiving, blocking, and throwing to handling pitchers and being the leader of the infield.

INFIELD CLINIC: 1:30-3:30pm Cost \$60

Fielders will develop their skillset and fine tune their fundamentals. Position specific breakdown will be the focus with emphasis on daily drills.

HITTING CLINIC: 4:00-6:00pm Cost \$60

This clinic will focus on the fundamentals of the swing and drills to develop you into an elite hitter. Learn approach and routines to become a more consistent hitter.

COACHES CLINIC: 1:00-7:00pm Cost \$30

Opportunity to learn sound instruction and drill sets regarding pitching, catching, infield play and hitting. Interact with Olympian Lori Harrigan and Marshall Softball staff & players. Dinner included.

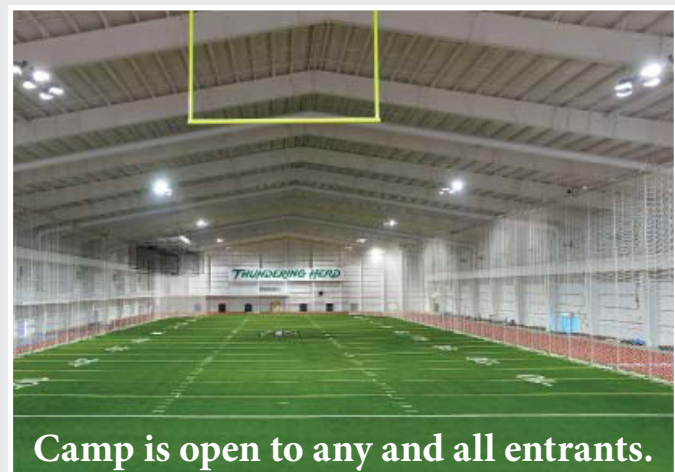
